FINANCIAL OPTIONS

The team at State Endodontics extends their commitment to providing excellent dental care by offering payment options to fit your individual needs. ABOUT ENDODONTICS

Endodontists are dentists with at least two additional years of advanced education in root canal techniques and procedures. There are various reasons you may see an Endodontist, but in all cases, we are trying to save your tooth. Endodontic Therapy is an alternative to extraction and replacement with artificial teeth. Typically, you would see the care of an Endodontist if the pulp of your tooth has become inflamed due to disease, decay, or trauma, which includes cracked or knocked-out teeth.

PATIENT PROTECTION & COMFORT

Here at State Endodontics, we are committed to providing a safe and clean experience for every patient. All of our staff are trained on compliant infection control policies and our practice is compliant with all standards as required through the CDC and OSHA.

Your comfort is our priority. We strive to provide a relaxing and pleasant experience every time you visit.

A clinical and radiographic examination (X-ray) is performed. Afterwards, the doctor will discuss your diagnosis and treatment options.

ENDODONTIC THERAPY

Local anesthetic is used to numb the area where a small opening is made in the crown of the tooth. The canal is then cleaned, disinfected, and shaped. The canals are then filled, sealing the tooth permanently.

AFTER THE PROCEDURE

You can expect some soreness, pressure, and slight swelling for up to a few days. This discomfort is a normal reaction however and will not affect the success of your treatment.

FOLLOW UP TREATMENT

Once your endodontic therapy is completed, a temporary filling is placed in the access opening for an interim period. You will need to schedule another appointment with your general dentist to apply the permanent restoration to your tooth.
